Gutters should be at the top of your list of things to check, because clogged gutters can destroy your shingles, downspouts and affect your foundation!

So how can you avoid a huge, time-sucking and possibly dangerous activity like cleaning out your gutters every month? We have a great solution that will save time and headache (and keep you off of that ladder).

Why this gutter protection system versus any other kind?

The ingenious design is superior to any other gutter protection system available.

Pro Flow Gutter Protection features a rubber-based insert that is angled at 45 degrees to provide gutter support and ensure the flow is always down and away from your house.

Pro Flow Gutter Protection also features a low-profile look, designed to not be noticed from the road, helping you with your curb appeal and not drawing attention to your gutters.

Pro Flow Gutter Protection also features a longer front lip, designed to extend beyond the gutter to help avoid "tiger striping". Tiger striping is an unsightly accumulation of dirt that follows down the side of the gutter when they are overloaded. The way to avoid this is to use Pro Flow Gutter Protection (to make sure you don't get clogged) and to use a longer lip on the front.

What type of debris does this protect me against?

1. Roof shingle granules
2. Sticks
3. Dirt
4. Leaves
5. Bugs
6. Pine needles
7. Bird nest & feathers
8. Cottonwood

Sticks are especially dangerous because they can create a place for more other debris to pile up. Roof shingle granules are notorious for piling up because they form a heavy sludge in the bottom of your shingle. The Pro Flow Gutter Protection system holes are not large enough for these granules to pass through, ensuring they stay out of your gutter and cannot build up that sludge.

Pro Flow Gutter Protection system actually comes in 5 standard colors to match most common gutter types that are available in the marketplace: Clay, Wicker, White, Brown and Black, so combined with the low-profile, you'll never even notice they are installed.
